DESIGN FOR FOUNTAINS AND STATUARY.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,352**, dated June 27, 1876; application filed June 8, 1876.
[Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern :

Be it known that I, J. W. FISKE, of New York, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented certain Improvements in Designs for Fountains and Statuary, of which the following is a specification:

This design consists of a figure of Neptune sitting on a shell, with a dolphin's head on each side, and with sea-plants clinging to it. The dolphins are resting on a large rock, which forms a base for the whole structure. The figure has its foot resting on the back of the dolphin on the right, and in its hands holds a trident, pointing downward, as though in the act of spearing the head of the dolphin therewith. The left leg of the figure with the foot thereof hangs suspended loosely in front, as

shown. There is one large jet out of the mouth of each dolphin, and two out of the nostrils, besides various others surrounding the body of the figure.

This design is adapted for use either as a fountain or simply as statuary.

What I claim is—

The herein-described design for a fountain or statuary, consisting of the figure of Neptune seated on a shell, with a trident, and dolphins, as shown in the accompanying photograph.
