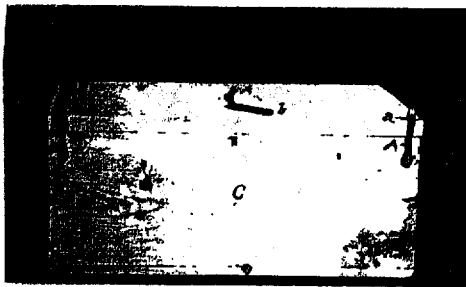

DESIGN FOR COFFIN-HOOK.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,354**, dated June 27, 1876; application filed May 10, 1876.

[Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, GAYLORD S. GRAVES, of Bainbridge, in the county of Chenango and State of New York, have originated and designed an Ornamental Hook, of which the following is a full and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying photographic illustration, making a part of this specification.

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying photographic illustration, to which reference is made.

A represents the body of the hook. At the end of the stem there is an eye, bordered with a semi-hexagonal figure, having scalloped sides. The inside face is at a right angle with the turn of the hook, and from the center of the eye the stem is curved on the three outer sides

to the heel of the hook, which is also curved on the inside, and surmounted with a scalloped crest. The termination of the inside curve of the hook and curved point form its bearing-edge.

The body of the hook may be ornamented by plating, or otherwise finished, as desired.

The distinguishing character of my design is found in the configuration of the hook, as fully shown in the photographic illustration.

What I claim as invention is—

A design for a hook, ornamented substantially as herein described.
