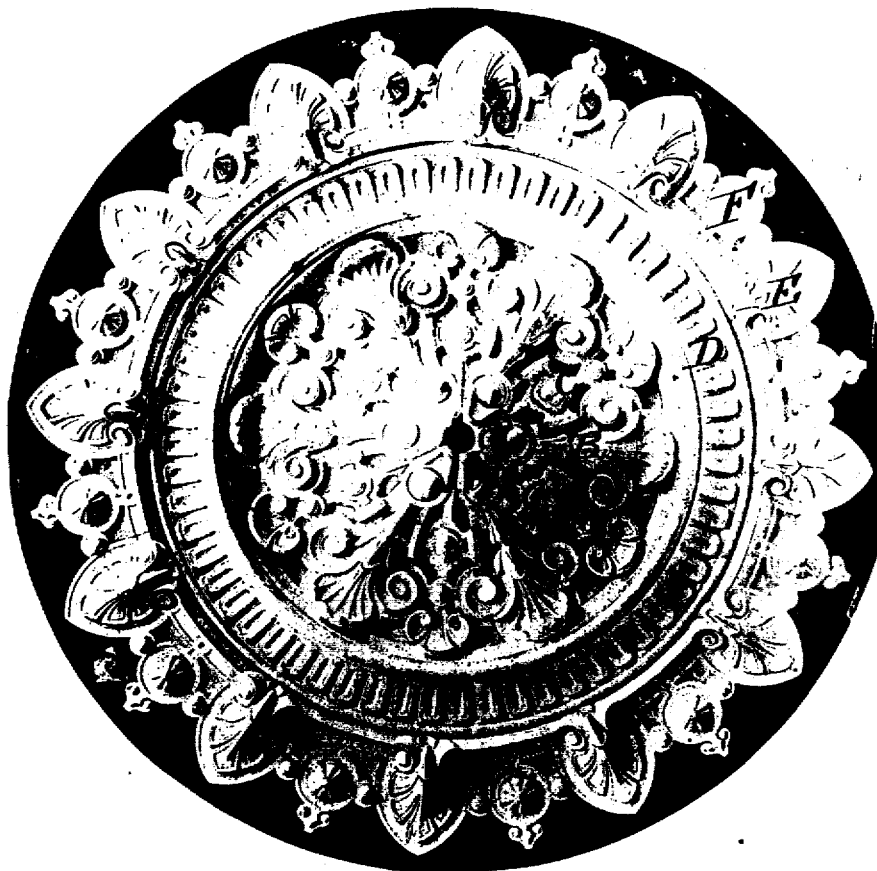

DESIGN FOR CENTER-PIECE.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,367**, dated July 4, 1876; application filed March 13, 1876.
[Term of Patent 14 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, SAMUEL KELLETT, of the city and county of San Francisco, State of California, have invented a new and original Design for a Center-Piece, of which the following is a specification:

The invention is illustrated in the accompanying photograph, and by letters marked thereon.

My design consists of three portions: the inner rosette form, which is composed of two figures alternating; the middle molded portion of center-piece, with fluted semi-oval forms placed between moldings; and outside border, which is highly ornamental.

The letter A designates drop of center-

piece; B, stem and leaf figure scrolled on sides; C, design between leaves; D, semi-oval forms between moldings; E, principal figure of border, which is composed of fillets as base of design, with raised leaf; F, rosette, with pointed terminal. These last described forms are connected.

Having thus described my invention, what I claim as new, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The design for center-piece, as shown and described.
