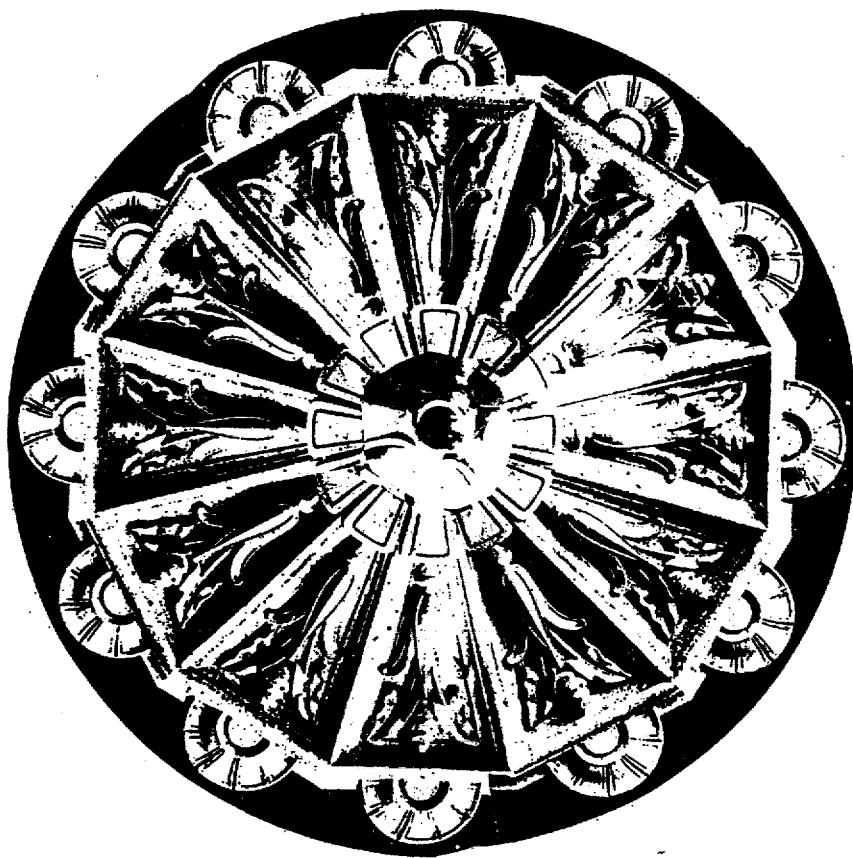

DESIGN FOR CENTER-PIECE.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,370**, dated July 4, 1876; application filed March 13, 1876.
[Term of Patent 14 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, SAMUEL KELLETT, of the city and county of San Francisco, State of California, have invented a new and original Design for a Center-Piece, reference being had to the accompanying photograph and letters marked thereon.

My design is composed of paneled forms molded. In each panel stems, leaves, and seed of flower are placed. A plain engraved circular figure is placed against outer molding of panels. The design is capped with a plain figured base and drop, as shown.

The letter A designates molded panel with stems, leaves, and seed placed within; B, the figure outside and on end of panel; C and D, capping and drop of design.

This style of paneling may be used in less numbers to form a complete design.

What I claim as new, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The design for center-piece, as shown.
