

DESIGN FOR CENTER-PIECE.

Specification forming part of Design No. 9,391, dated July 11, 1876; application filed June 26, 1876. [Term of Patent 14 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, SAML. KELLETT, of the city and county of San Francisco, State of California, have invented a new and original Design for a Center-Piece, of which the fol-

lowing is a specification:

This design consists in a drop on a molded disk, leaves with rounds on inner ends, fillets on sides, and turned over on the outer ends, as shown. These leaves surround the disk—clusters of fruit and leaves in circles, antique leaves in arched panels, and curled scrolls on ends of the latter. The last-described figures are connected by bead - moldings intersecting them.

The letter A designates the drop of the center-piece; B, leaves that surround the disk; C, clusters of fruit and leaves; D, antique leaf in arched panels; E, irregular panel.

Having thus described my invention, what I

claim as new, and desire to secure by Letters

Patent, is-

The design for a center-piece, as shown and described.
