## DESIGN FOR A FONT OF PRINTING-TYPES.

Specification forming part of Design No. 9,398, dated July 18, 1876; application filed May 23, 1876.  
[Term of Patent 14 years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, HERMAN IHLENBURG, (assignor to MACKELLAR, SMITHS & JORDAN) of the city and county of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania,) have invented and produced a new and original Design for a Font of Printing-Types, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is clearly shown in the accompanying typographic impression, to which reference is made; and consists of an open-face letter, ornamented with horizontal lines, heavier and closer together near the top of the letter, and joining the outline of

the letter upon the right side. The letter is shaded by heavy and light lines extending angularly from the lower and right sides; and from the light line extend short light lines in the direction shown.

Having now described my design, what I claim as new is—

The design for a font of printing-types, as shown and described.
