DESIGN FOR A FONT OF PRINTING-TYPES.

Specification forming part of Design No. 9,400, dated July 18, 1876; application filed May 31, 1876.
[Term of Patent 14 years.]

To all whom it may concern :

Be it known that I, HERMAN IHLENBURG, (assignor to MACKELLAR, SMITHS & JORDAN,) of the city and county of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented and originated a new Design for a Font of Printing-Types, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is clearly shown in the accompanying typographic impression, to which reference is made; and consists of an open-face text letter, shaded by a black line and a series of light lines extending angularly from the lower and right sides of the letter. The open face is ornamented by a series of light horizontal lines joining the outline of the

letter upon the right side; and where it can be advantageously used, as in the case of the letters B, C, D, E, F, and others, a shaded diamond-shaped ornament is employed either upon the left hand side of the body of the letter or placed within the open face of the same.

Having now set forth my design, what I claim as new is—

The design for a font of printing-types, as shown and described.
