DESIGN FOR A FONT OF PRINTING-TYPES.

Specification forming part of Design No. 9,401, dated July 18, 1876; application filed May 22, 1876.

[Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Andrew Little, of the city, county, and State of New York, have invented and originated a new Design for a Font of Printing-Types, of which the follow-

ing is a specification:

The nature of my design is clearly shown in the accompanying typographic impression, to which reference is made; and consists of a letter in which the up and down strokes, as in the letters A, H, and others, are provided with the triangular terminations at the top and bottom, and in which the horizontal lines, as in the letters B, D, and others, are heavier than the up and down lines, and terminate angularly. The letters J, L, and U have the

triangular termination at the top of the up and down lines only. In the lower-case and figures the triangular terminations occur at the top and bottom, and the angular terminations are also preserved, and characterize in some letters the up and down as well as the horizontal lines.

Having now set forth my design, what I claim as new is—

The design for a font of printing-types, as shown and described.
