

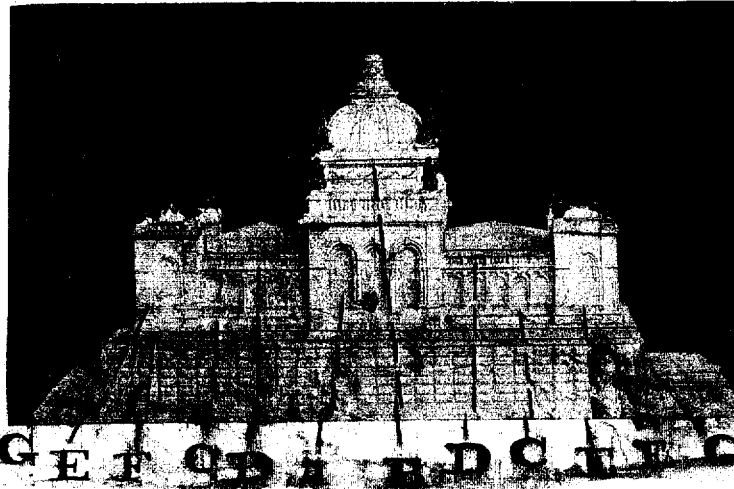

IMPROVEMENT IN DESIGN FOR INKSTANDS.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,415**, dated August 1, 1876; application filed March 20, 1876.
[Term of Patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.]

To all whom it may concern :

Be it known that I, WILLIAM D. BENNAGE, Jr., of the city and county of Philadelphia, and State of Pennsylvania, have originated and designed a new and useful Design for Inkstands, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying photographic illustration, making part of this specification.

The design consists of a building, the central portion A of which has a separated dome, B. The side wings C C have separated domes D, and at the corners of the wings there are towers E. In front of the building is a separated plateau, F. The building is mounted on a scored base, G. The whole forms a beautiful and attractive design.

I am aware that the central part A, dome B, side wings C, and corner towers E are not new, and therefore disclaim the same, broadly; but I am not aware that the front plateau F and scored base G have been combined with the above features, and I therefore believe that I have made a new design.

What I claim as my invention is—

The design for inkstand, the same consisting of the central part A, with separated dome B, side wings C, with separated domes D, corner towers E, front plateau F, and scored base G, all as shown and set forth.
