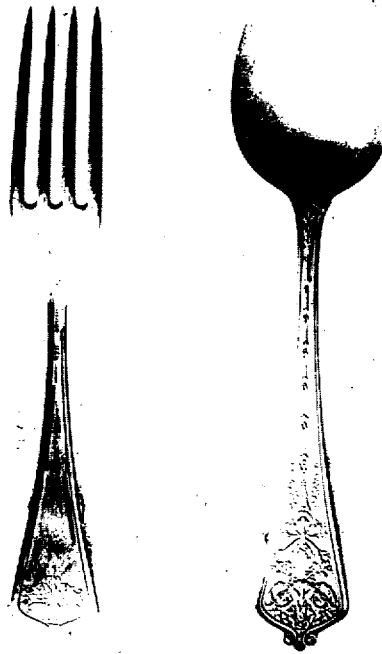

DESIGN FOR SPOON AND FORK HANDLES.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,420**, dated August 1, 1876; application filed July 11, 1876.
[Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, GEORGE WILKINSON, of the city and county of Providence and State of Rhode Island, have invented a new and original Design for the Handles of Spoons and Forks in Silver and Plated Wares, of which the following is a specification:

In the accompanying photograph, Figure 1 represents a front view of the design, which consists of a raised border-line, of the form as indicated in the photograph, the said border-line inclosing the main features of the design, consisting of scroll-work, wreaths, leaves, and

branches, surrounding the prominent feature of the design—viz., a female head in cameo form—substantially as shown in the said photograph; Fig. 2 representing the reverse view of the said design.

I claim as my invention—

The design for spoon and fork handles, substantially as herein set forth.
