

DESIGN FOR WOOLEN FABRICS.

Specification forming part of Design No. 9,424, dated August 1,1876; application filed June 30, 1876.

[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, DAVID L. EINSTEIN, of the city, county, and State of New York, have invented a new and original Design for Woolen Fabrics, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my invention is fully shown in the accompanying photographic illustration, to which reference is made.

A represents the woolen fabric, whose nap

is so raised as to form oblique rows of ribs in pairs alternately at right angles, and with each rib bent reversely at its opposite ends.

What I claim is—

The design for woolen fabrics, substantially as shown and described.
