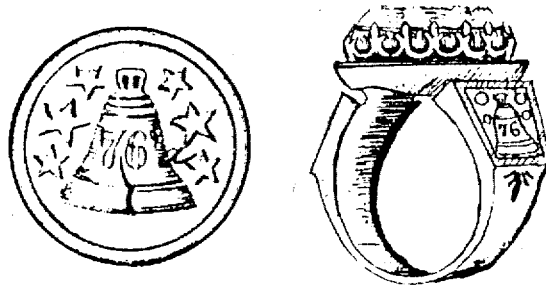

DESIGN FOR A BADGE.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,432**, dated August 1, 1876; application filed April 10, 1876.
[Term of Patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ALBERT V. MOORE, of Hackensack, Bergen county, New Jersey, have invented a Design for Jewelry, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying photographic illustration, to which reference is made.

The said design consists of the representation of a bell, *a*, with the figures "76" on the top or face of a badge, sleeve-button, or stud,

and it also consists of the figures of stars in connection with the bell.

I claim as my invention—

The design for a badge, sleeve-button, or stud, consisting of the representation of stars in connection with the figure of a bell, substantially as shown and described.
