DESIGN FOR A FONT OF PRINTING-TYPES.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,433**, dated August 8, 1876; application filed May 22, 1876.
[Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JAMES M. CONNER, of Greenville, Hudson county, New Jersey, have invented and produced a new and Original Design for a Font of Printing-Type, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is clearly shown in the accompanying typographic impression, to which reference is made, and consists of a letter formed with heavy face, and all the terminations of which are angular. The letter is shaded by a hair-line connected with the body of the letter, and placed at the right and lower sides of it, and terminating angularly. The letters B, C, D, G, O, Q, and S, and

the figures 3 6 8 9 0, and the symbol &, and the dollar-mark, have angular ornaments at the top and bottom. The letters J, U, V, and W, and the figure 5, are provided with angular ornaments at the bottom, and the letters A, M, N, P, and R, and the figures 2 and 4, have angular ornaments at the top.

Having now set forth my design, what I claim as new is—

The design for a font of printing-type, as shown and described.
