

DESIGN FOR A FINGER-RING.

Specification forming part of Design No. 9,436, dated August 8, 1876; application filed April 10, 1876.

[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ALBERT V. MOORE, of Hackensack, Bergen county, New Jersey, have invented a Design for Finger-Rings, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying drawing, to which refer-

ence is made.

The said design consists of the dates "1776" and "1876," and the figures of stars in the top or face of a finger-ring.

On the face or setting of the ring is arranged a central star, surrounded by the oppositely-

placed dates "1876" and "1776," together with two stars that separate these dates on opposite sides.

I claim as my invention-

The design for a finger-ring, composed of the dates "1776" and 1876," together with the figures of stars, as described, and shown in the accompanying drawing.
