

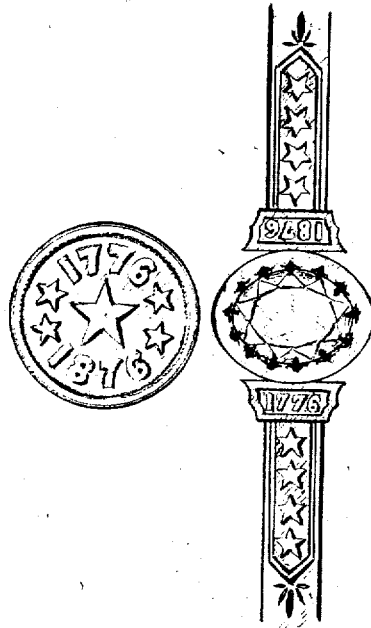

## DESIGN FOR A FINGER-RING.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,436**, dated August 8, 1876; application filed April 10, 1876.

[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, ALBERT V. MOORE, of Hackensack, Bergen county, New Jersey, have invented a Design for Finger-Rings, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying drawing, to which reference is made.

The said design consists of the dates "1776" and "1876," and the figures of stars in the top or face of a finger-ring.

On the face or setting of the ring is arranged a central star, surrounded by the oppositely-

placed dates "1876" and "1776," together with two stars that separate these dates on opposite sides.

I claim as my invention—

The design for a finger-ring, composed of the dates "1776" and "1876," together with the figures of stars, as described, and shown in the accompanying drawing.
