

DESIGN FOR CENTER-PIECE.

Specification forming part of Design No. 9,440, dated August 15, 1876; application filed July 3, 1876. [Term of Patent 14 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, SAMUEL KELLETT, of the city and county of San Francisco, State of California, have invented a new and original Design for a Center-Piece, of which the following is a specification:

The invention is illustrated in the accompanying photograph, which represents a face

view of design.

The central portion of design is highly ornamental, and consists in a drop of leaves and balls on base of drop. Four leading figures extend from base of drop to bead-molding, the ends of which are scrolled, holding stems that flow out fine scrolls to right and left. Leaflike shells surmount these figures. Between these described forms are placed shields with large balls in center, surrounded by small balls. A circular panel, composed of ovals on raised base, makes second division of de-

sign. The outer border is composed of two figures. The large figure is heart-shaped, inclosing engraved leaf. The lesser form is a small device, placed on plain ground, which is curled on sides touching larger figure.

The letter A designates drop of center-piece; B, leading figure, with shell surmounting; C C, scrolls, flowing out from end of figure; D, shields with balls in center; E, panel surrounding inner forms; F, heart-shaped figure; G, small device.

Having thus described my invention, what I claim as new, and desire to secure by Letters Patent. is—

The design for center-piece, as set forth and described.
