

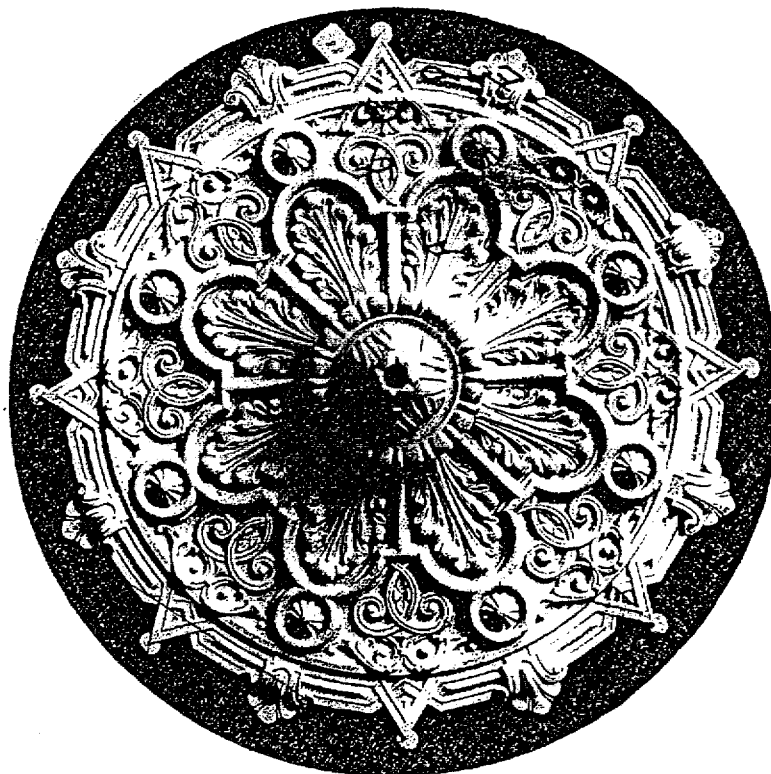

DESIGN FOR CENTER-PIECE.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,441**, dated August 15, 1876; application filed July 3, 1876.
[Term of Patent 14 years.]

To all whom it may concern :

Be it known that I, SAMUEL KELLETT, of the city and county of San Francisco, State of California, have invented a new and original Design for a Center-Piece, of which the following is a specification :

The invention is illustrated in the accompanying photograph, which represents a face view of design.

The letter A designates central portion or drop of center-piece. B designates wreath composed of stems, leaves, and fruit between moldings. The border or outside finish is

composed of half-circular fillets C C, touching bead-molding, rosette D on points. A shell, E, fills space between inner edges of fillets.

Having thus described my invention, what I claim as new, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The design for center-piece, as shown and described.
