

DESIGN FOR CENTER-PIECE.

Specification forming part of Design No. 9,442, dated August 15, 1876; application filed July 3, 1876.

[Term of Patent 14 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, SAML. KELLETT, of the city and county of San Francisco, State of California, have invented a new and original Design for a Center-Piece, of which the following is a specification:

The invention is illustrated in the accompanying photograph, which represents a face

view of design.

The central portion of center-piece is paneled, with leaf in each panel, rosettes in circles on ends of panels, fine scrolls starting from T-shaped ends of panels, overlapping and curling on touching round ends of panels, leaf-scrolls to right and left, the ends touching circles. The outer edging is composed of

double bands, overlapping at intervals, with round balls on points. A leaf clasps over bands.

The letter A designates panel with leaf; B, rosettes in circles; C C, scrolls between panels, rosettes, and outer border; D D, bands that form outer finish; E, leaf clasping over bands.

Having thus described my invention, what I claim as new, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The design for a center-piece, as shown and described.
