

## DESIGN FOR CENTER-PIECE.

Specification forming part of Design No. 9,443, dated August 15, 1876; application filed July 3, 1876.

[Term of Patent 14 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, SAMUEL KELLETT, of the city and county of San Francisco, State of California, have invented a new and original Design for a Center-Piece, of which the following is a specification:

The invention is illustrated in the accompanying photograph, which represents a face

view of design.

Two forms, repeating, compose the whole of design, with capping and drop in central portion. The letter A designates the large figure, which is raised in middle, upon which are placed

a stem and leaf. Straight and curved lines, sunk, relieve plainness of figure on sides and ends of leaves. A stem, B, with seed or bud on external end, makes the secondary figure.

What I claim as new, and desire to secure

by Letters Patent, is-

The design for a center-piece, as shown and described.
