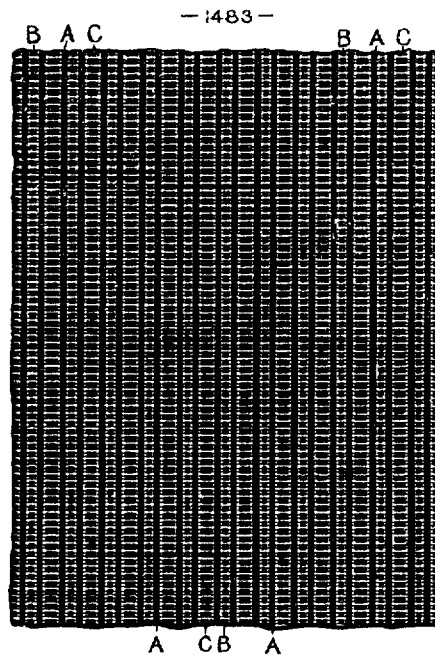

DESIGN FOR FABRIC.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,466**, dated August 22, 1876; application filed August 4, 1876.
[Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, ROBERT SCOTT and AARON JEWELL, both of Lawrence, in the county of Essex and State of Massachusetts, have invented a new Design for Fancy Worsted or Woolen Fabrics; and we do hereby declare that the following specification, taken in connection with the drawing making a part of the same, is a full, clear, and exact description thereof.

The design which is the subject of this patent consists in the combination of longitudinal lines and stripes, as hereinafter described. Longitudinal corded lines A are arranged in alternation with longitudinal cross-barred stripes B and C, of slightly different widths, the corded lines separating the cross-barred stripes, as shown.

The fabric may be woven in any preferred variety or combination of colors for giving effect to the design above described, the characteristic feature of which is the combination of corded lines and cross-barred stripes, as shown.

What we claim is—

The design for fancy worsted or woolen fabrics, substantially as herein described, and represented in the drawing.
