

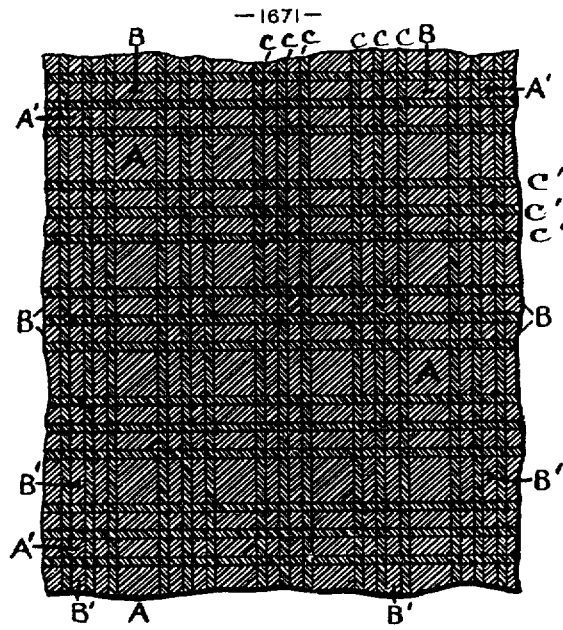

ROBERT SCOTT AND AARON JEWELL, OF LAWRENCE, MASSACHUSETTS.

DESIGN FOR FABRIC.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,171**, dated August 22, 1876; application filed August 4, 1876.
[Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern :

Be it known that we, ROBERT SCOTT and AARON JEWELL, both of Lawrence, in the county of Essex and State of Massachusetts, have invented a new Design for Fancy Worsted or Woolen Fabrics; and we do hereby declare that the following specification, taken in connection with the drawing making a part of the same, is a full, clear, and exact description thereof.

The effect of our novel design will be apparent from an inspection of the accompanying drawing, to which reference is made, said effect being produced as follows: The general surface of the fabric is shaded by diagonal lines, and is cut into squares A A', and rectangles B B', by triple narrow stripes C C' running longitudinally and transversely of the fabric, the said stripes being shaded by diagonal lines, whose direction is opposite or at right angles to that of the shade-lines of the general surface.

The fabric may be woven in any preferred variety or combination of colors for giving effect to the design above described, the characteristic feature of which is a general surface shaded by diagonal lines, and divided into squares and rectangles by triple narrow stripes running longitudinally and transversely of the fabric, the stripes being diagonally shaded in a direction at right angles to the general surface.

What we claim is—

The design for fancy worsted or woolen fabrics, substantially as herein described, and represented in the drawing.
