

ROBERT SCOTT AND AARON JEWELL, OF LAWRENCE, MASSACHUSETTS.

DESIGN FOR FABRIC.

Specification forming part of Design No. 9,472, dated August 22, 1876; application filed August 4, 1876. [Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, ROBERT SCOTT and AARON JEWELL, both of Lawrence, in the county of Essex and State of Massachusetts, have invented a new Design for Fancy Worsted or Woolen Fabrics; and we do hereby declare that the following specification, taken in connection with the drawing making a part of the same, is a full, clear, and exact description therof.

The design which is the subject of this patent consists in the combination of peculiar longitudinal stripes, as hereinafter described.

A is a broad triple stripe, composed of the three members a, b, and c, the center member b being made up of cross-bars, and the side members a c being shaded by diagonal lines extending in opposite directions converging. This triple stripe A is in alternation with a stripe, B, which has a ground of plain weaving, upon which are placed three alternat-

ing longitudinal lines of cross-bars, the bars being arranged in sets of three, and the sets connected by shortlongitudinal bars, as shown.

The fabric may be woven in any preferred variety or combination of colors for giving effect to the design above described, the distinctive character of which is a three-membered stripe composed of cross-bars and diagonal lines, in alternation with a stripe having a ground of plain weaving, upon which are placed bars arranged as shown.

What we claim is-

The design for fancy worsted or woolen fabrics, substantially as herein described, and represented in the drawing.
