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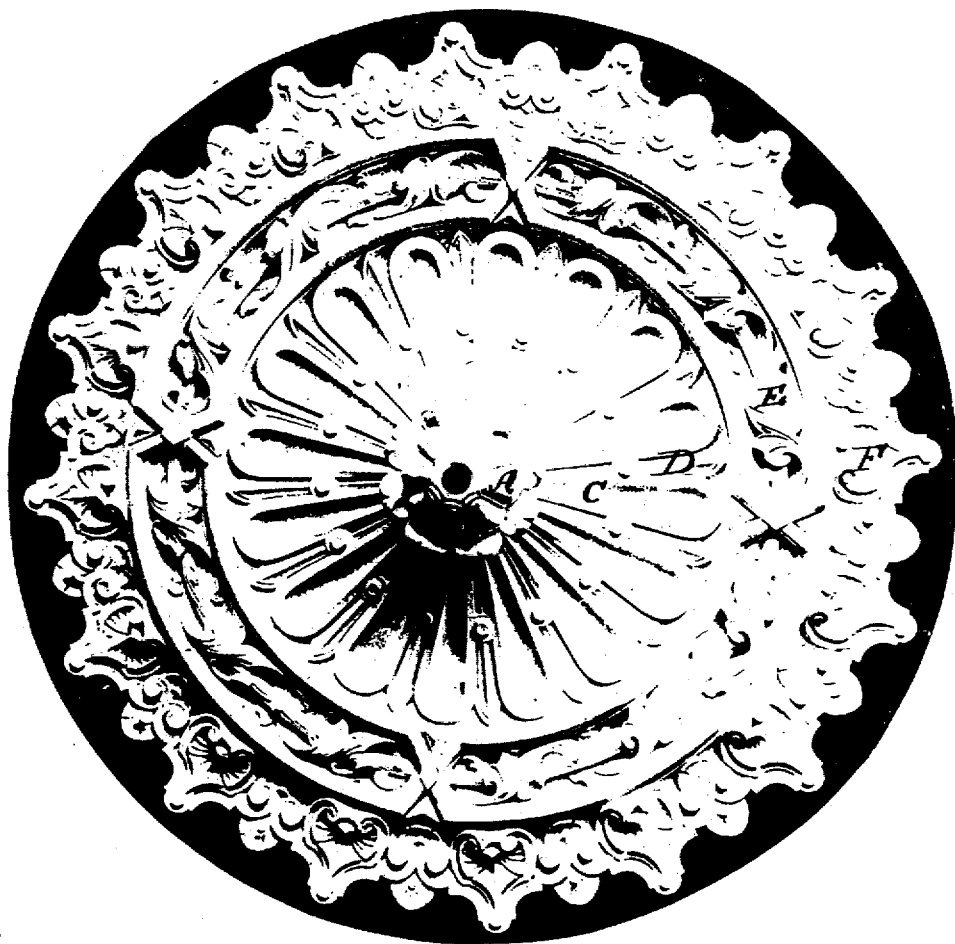

DESIGN FOR CENTER-PIECE.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,475**, dated August 29, 1876; application filed May 22, 1876.
[Term of Patent 14 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, SAMUEL KELLETT, of the city and county of San Francisco, State of California, have invented a new and original Design for a Center-Piece, of which the following is a specification:

My invention is illustrated in the accompanying photograph, which represents a face view of design.

The letter A designates drop of center-piece, with leaves at base turning downward; C, fluting, with plain bands connecting at middle of figures; D, tongue separating flutes. Four panels beaded on sides, X, shaped on ends, surround inner forms. In each panel, E, a stem or vine is placed with leaves curling

round. Outer portion of center-piece is composed of raised figures F, shell-like scrolls on ends touching bead of panels and middle connections. Flat fillets on outer edge; round dots on points with small device, placed between and against outer fillets.

Having thus described my invention, what I claim as new, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The design for center-piece, as shown and described.
