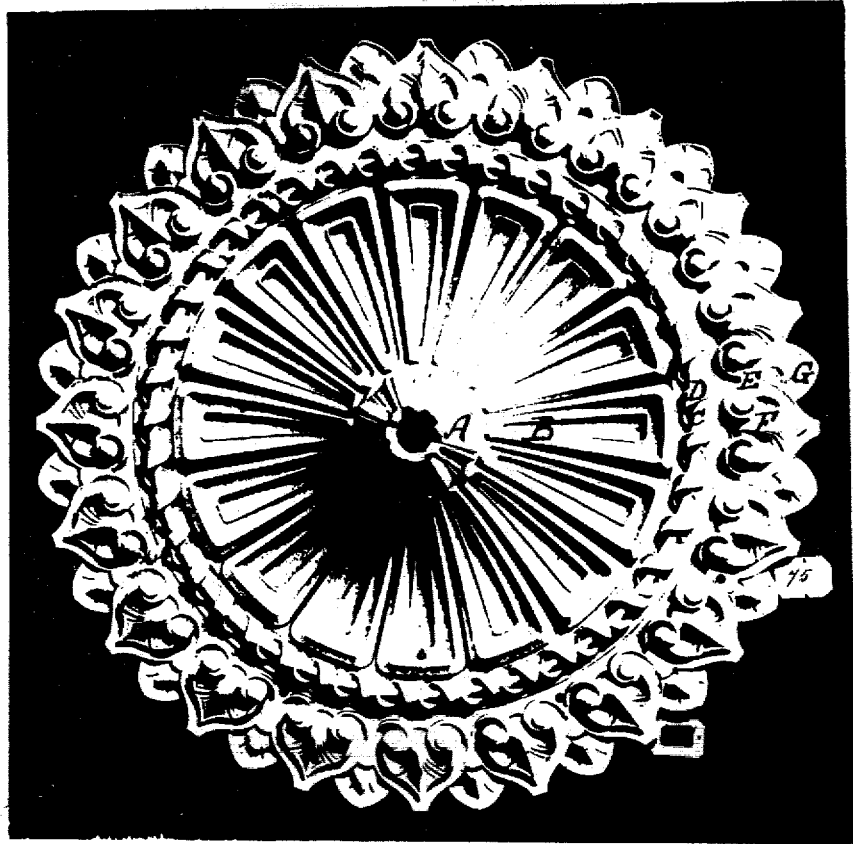

## DESIGN FOR CENTER-PIECE.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,476**, dated August 29, 1876; application filed May 22, 1876.

[Term of Patent 14 years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, SAMUEL KELLETT, of the city and county of San Francisco, State of California, have invented and produced a new and original Design for a Center - Piece, reference being had to the accompanying photograph, and to letters marked thereon.

My new design is, in order, Grecian. Commencing with drop A, as shown, radiating fluted forms B, repeating, form the inner portion of center - piece, around which a plain bead, C, with ribbon D, winding round place in sinkage, divides inner figures from outer

border, which is composed of flat bands E E, formed to receive engraved leaf F. A small plain figure, G, as filling in, completes the edging of outer finish.

Having thus described my invention, what I claim as new, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The design for a center - piece, as set forth and described.
