DESIGN FOR AN ORNAMENTAL CASTING.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,484**, dated August 29, 1876; application filed June 5, 1876.
[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ADELIO MIOZZI, of the city, county, and State of New York, have originated and designed a new Design for an Ornamental Casting, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, making part of this specification.

The drawing represents a face view of my design.

This design consists of an eagle, having spread wings and a curved neck, and grasping in his talons several spears, in combination with a drum, a bundle of fasces, with an axe, a gun, and wiper, a wreath, and United States flags, two on each side.

In the drawing, the letter A designates an eagle, with spread wings *a a*, a curved neck, *b*, and grasping with his talons a series of spears, *c*. From one side of this eagle project a gun, *d*, and a wiper, *e*, and from the other side extends a bundle of fasces, *f*, over a drum,

g. With this eagle is combined a circular wreath, *h*, the ends of which terminate opposite to a star, *i*. From the sides of this wreath project United States flags B B, two on each side. The space inclosed by the wreaths *h* is occupied by a portrait.

What I claim as new, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The design for an ornamental casting, consisting of an eagle, A, with spread wings *a a*, curved neck *b*, grasping with his talons a series of spears, *c*, all grouped together, with a gun, *d*, wiper *e*, bundle of fasces *f*, drum *g*, wreath *h*, star *i*, and flags B B, all as shown and described.
