## DESIGN FOR AN ALTO-RELIEVO.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,497**, dated September 19, 1876; application filed August 14, 1876.  
[Term of Patent 7 years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, BALDWIN COOLIDGE, of Lawrence, in the county of Essex and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, have originated and Designed an Alto-Relievo for ornamental purposes, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying photographic illustration, making part of this specification.

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying photographic illustration, to which reference is made.

My design consists of an alto-relievo (formed within an oval ground and surrounding, having raised edge or frame, the surface of the background being concave) of a child's face, (girl's,) which I designate as "Mother's Darling," the distinctive features of which are a young and childlike face, looking slightly to

its right, with smiling countenance, full face, prominent eyes, full and expressive forehead, flowing curls, hair combed directly back and over the crest of the head, with light banging of hair across and above the brow, having insertion-collar and tucked waist, with double ruffling down the front, showing the top button.

The accompanying photograph shows a nearly front view of my alto-relievo.

What I claim, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The design for an alto-relievo representing a child's face, substantially as described, and shown in the accompanying illustration.
