

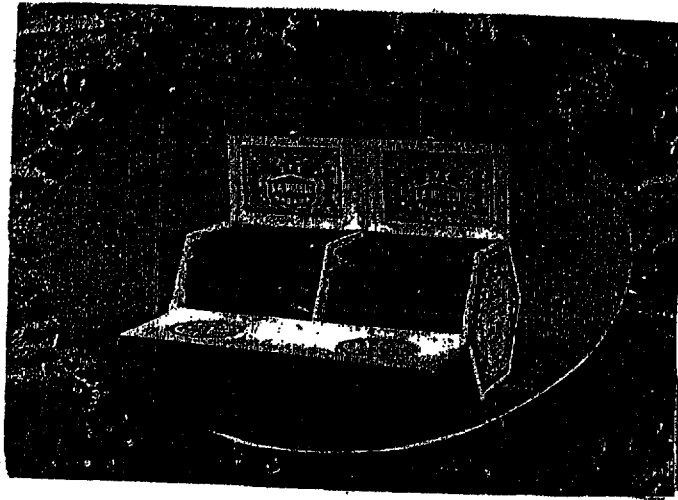

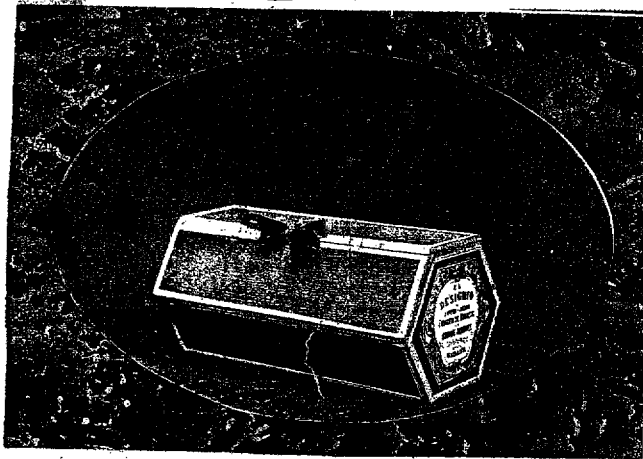

## DESIGN FOR CIGAR-BOX.

Specification forming part of Design No. 9,572, dated October 3, 1876; application filed May 27, 1876.  
[Term of Patent 7 years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, SAMUEL S. WIEST, of Schoeneck, Lancaster county, Pennsylvania, have invented a Design for Cigar-Boxes, of which the following is a specification:

My design for cigar-boxes is fully represented in the accompanying photographic illustration, to which reference is made, and in which—

Figure 1 is a perspective view of the box closed, and Fig. 2 is a perspective view of it open.

The said design consists of an oblong box, A, having a hexagonal shape in cross-section, formed by the ends B, as shown. Two of the adjacent sides open in opposite directions.

I claim as my invention and desire to secure by Letters Patent—

The design for a cigar-box, substantially as shown and described.
