

DESIGN FOR PARLOR-STOVES.

Specification forming part of Design No. 9,575, dated October 3, 1876; application filed September 26, 1876. [Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, FRANK A. MAGEE, of Chelsea, in the county of Suffolk and State of Massachusetts, have invented and produced a new and original Design for a Parlor-Stove, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying engraving, making part of this specification.

In the engraving, A represents the body or main portion of the stove, which is of cylindrical form, and rests upon the base B, which is supported upon ornamental legs 5, and is provided at each corner with a short ornamental column, a, having on its broadest face a figure, b, in bass relief. On each side of the base B, between the columns a of two contiguous corners, are one or more figures, c, in bass relief. At the front of the base is an ornamental door, d, containing the draft-slide, and below this door is the hearth C. D is the door through which the fuel is introduced into the stove, and E the frame to which the door is pivoted. This door-frame consists of a base, e, and two ornamental pillars, f, forming the side pieces, the latter supporting an ornamental top piece, g, of the form shown, having a panel at the center bearing the name I

of the stove. At each corner of the door D is an ornamental panel, h, of the form shown. The body A of the stove, which may be either circular or oval in cross-section, is surmounted by an ornamental top, E', having narrow curved panels i extending around it, medallion heads k being placed between these panels. The apex of the top E' forms a support for the base of the urn G of the form shown, which is provided with ornamental side handles l and a central rosette, m, in front and at the rear.

What I claim as my invention, and desire

to secure by Letters Patent, is-

1. The design of the base B of a cylindrical or oval-shaped stove, substantially as herein shown and described.

2. The design of the door-frame E, as herein shown and described.

3. The design of the urn G, as herein shown and described.
