DESIGN FOR A FONT OF PRINTING-TYPES.

Specification forming part of Design No. 9,582, dated October 10, 1876; application filed September 26, 1876. [Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JAMES M. CONNER, of Greenville, Hudson county, New Jersey, have invented and originated a new and original Design for a Font of Printing-Type, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is clearly shown in the accompanying typographic impression, to which reference is made; and consists of a letter the up and down strokes of which are curved and rounded at the top and bottom, shaded by a lighter line at the right and bottom of the letter. In the letters N, U, V, W, and Y, one of the up and down strokes as-

cends above the other up and down stroke.

These features are preserved in the figures and lower-case, save that no one of the up and down strokes ascends above the other in the formation of a figure or letter.

Having now described my invention, what I claim as new is-

The design for a font of printing-type, as

shown.
