DESIGN FOR A FONT OF PRINTING-TYPES.

Specification forming part of Design No. 9,582, dated October 10, 1876; application filed September 26, 1876.
[Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JAMES M. CONNER, of Greenville, Hudson county, New Jersey, have invented and originated a new and original Design for a Font of Printing-Type, of which the following is a specification :

The nature of my design is clearly shown in the accompanying typographic impression, to which reference is made; and consists of a letter the up and down strokes of which are curved and rounded at the top and bottom, shaded by a lighter line at the right and bottom of the letter. In the letters N, U, V, W, and Y, one of the up and down strokes ascends above the other up and down stroke.

These features are preserved in the figures and lower-case, save that no one of the up and down strokes ascends above the other in the formation of a figure or letter.

Having now described my invention, what I claim as new is—

The design for a font of printing-type, as shown.
