DESIGN FOR SPOON AND FORK HANDLES.

Specification forming part of Design No. 9,603, dated October 24, 1876; application filed August 26, 1876.
[Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, GEORGE WILKINSON, of the city and county of Providence, and State of Rhode Island, have invented a new and original Design for the Handles of Spoons and Forks in Silver and Plated Wares, of which the following is a specification:

In the accompanying photograph, Figure 1 represents a front view of the design, which consists of a raised border-line, *a*, inclosing the main features of the design, as shown in the said photograph. At about the center portion of the design the border-line encircles two (2) rosettes, *b b*, from the centers of which droop small ornamental figures *c c*, and above the said rosettes rises an orna-

ment consisting of nine, more or less, curved raised lines, *d*, and underneath the rosettes is an ornamental pendant, *f*, all of which features of said design are substantially as shown in the photograph. Fig. 2 represents the reverse view of the said design.

I claim as my invention—

The design for spoon and fork handles, substantially as herein set forth, and shown in the accompanying photograph.
