DESIGN FOR COMBINED MIRROR, MIRROR-FRAME, COMB-CASE, AND MATCH-SAFE.

Specification forming part of Design No. 9,605, dated October 31, 1876; application filed August 18, 1876. [Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WRIGHT CLAPP, of the city of South Bend, in the county of St. Joseph and State of Indiana, have originated and designed a Pattern for a Combined Mirror, Mirror-Frame, Comb-Case, and Match-Safe, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying photographic illustration or drawing, making a part of this specifica-

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying photographic illustration, to which reference is made.

A represents scroll-work at the top of the frame; and B represents the frame intended

to contain a mirror; and Crepresents the mirror; and D represents a comb case, which is attached to the back of the combined toiletset and mirror, and below the mirror; and E represents a match-safe attached to each side of the frame.

What I claim as my design is—

A design for combined mirror, mirror-frame, comb case, and match-safe, consisting of the scroll-work top A, mirror-frame B, mirror C, comb-case D, and match-safe E, all substantially as described and shown. WRIGHT CLAPP.
