


DESIGN FOR RUBBER SHOES.

Specification forming part of Design No. 9,662, dated December 5, 1876; application filed October 16, 1876.

[Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, CHRISTOPHER MEYER, of New Brunswick, in the county of Middlesex and State of New Jersey, have invented a new and Original Design for India-Rubber Boots and Shoes, of which the following is a specification:

My design for india-rubber boots and shoes is fully represented in the accompanying drawing, to which reference is made, and in which—

Figure 1 represents a side elevation of a shoe, and Fig. 2 represents a top view.

Similar letters of reference indicate corre-

sponding parts.

The said design consists of the raised ornamental side ribs a, arranged in the downward points b, with the scroll figured ribs c above said points, and with the scroll terminations d on the toe, said ribs crossing each other thereat. It also consists of scroll-ribs e, with point f on the instep, also of the parallel ribs ribs g in connection with scroll-ribs d and e,

and also of the curved ribs h, with the points i above scrolls c, and in connection with them.

I claim as my invention—

1. The design for india-rubber boots and shoes, consisting of the side ornamental ribs a, arranged in points b, together with scrolls c above said points, as set forth.

2. The ribs a with scroll terminations d on

the toe, as set forth.

3. The scroll-rib e with point f on the in-

step, as set forth.

4. The parallel ribs g on the top of the shoe, in connection with the scrolls d and e, as set forth.

5. The curved ribs h with points i on the instep, in connection with the scrolls e, as set forth.
