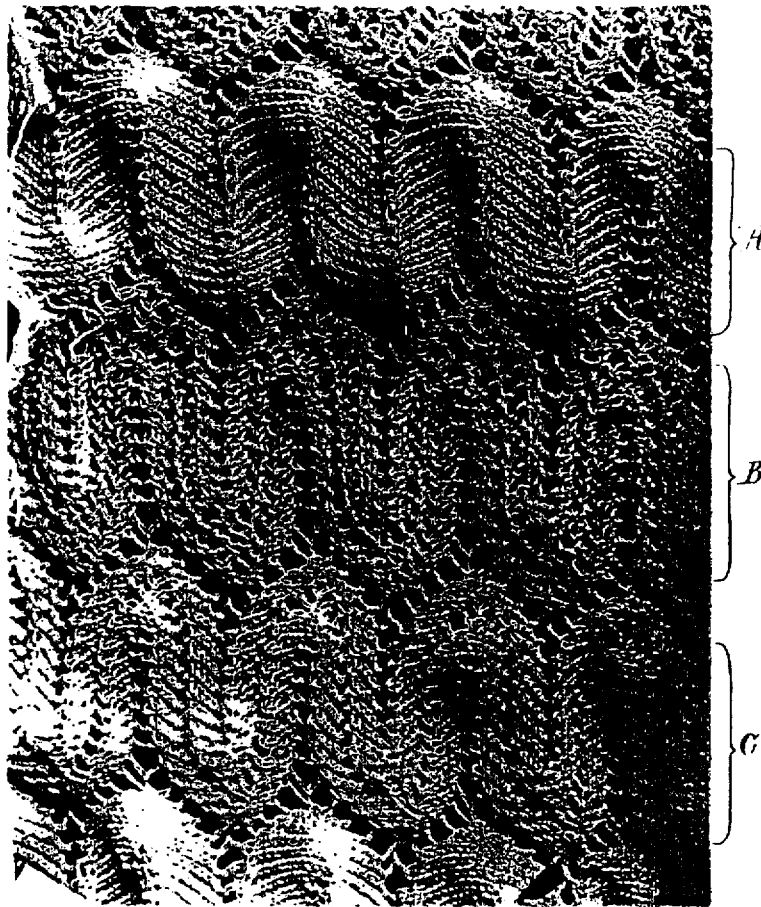

## DESIGN FOR KNITTED FABRIC.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,667**, dated December 12, 1876; application filed November 20, 1876.  
[Term of Patent 7 years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, MARTIN LANDENBERGER, of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented a new and original Design for a Knitted Fabric, of which the following is a specification:

My design is fully shown in the accompanying photographic illustration; and consists of a series of parallel stripes, A, B, C, &c., each stripe being of a waved or serpentine character.

The character of the stitch of the different stripes may be varied without affecting the character of the design.

I claim—

The design for a knitted fabric, composed of a series of parallel stripes of a serpentine character, substantially as described and shown.
