DESIGN FOR KNITTED FABRIC.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,668**, dated December 12, 1876; application filed November 20, 1876.
[Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, MARTIN LANDENBERGER, of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented a new and original Design for a Knitted Fabric, of which the following is a specification:

My design is fully shown in the accompanying photographic illustration; and consists of a body of knitted fabric having on the face shell-like protuberances *a*.

These protuberances may be variously ornamented, and their number and arrangement may also be varied, without altering the distinctive character of the design.

I claim—

The design for a knitted fabric having shell-like protuberances *a*, substantially as described, and as shown in and by the accompanying drawing.
