DESIGN FOR USE ON BILL-HEADS, &c.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,669**, dated December 12, 1876; application filed August 12, 1876.
[Term of Patent 14 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, DAVID L. PROUDFIT, of Plainfield, Union county, New Jersey, have originated a Design, intended more particularly for use on Bill-Heads, Checks, Receipts, and all Office Stationery, of which the following is a specification:

This design consists, as shown in the drawing, of a female figure in a standing position, supporting a shield. Alongside of and near the head of the female figure is a cherub holding in its hands a ribbon or pennant.

The details of the design will be gathered by reference to the accompanying drawing.

Any suitable inscription or ornamentation may be placed on the face of the shield. The design may be inclosed by a suitable border or frame.

What I claim, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The design herein described and shown.
