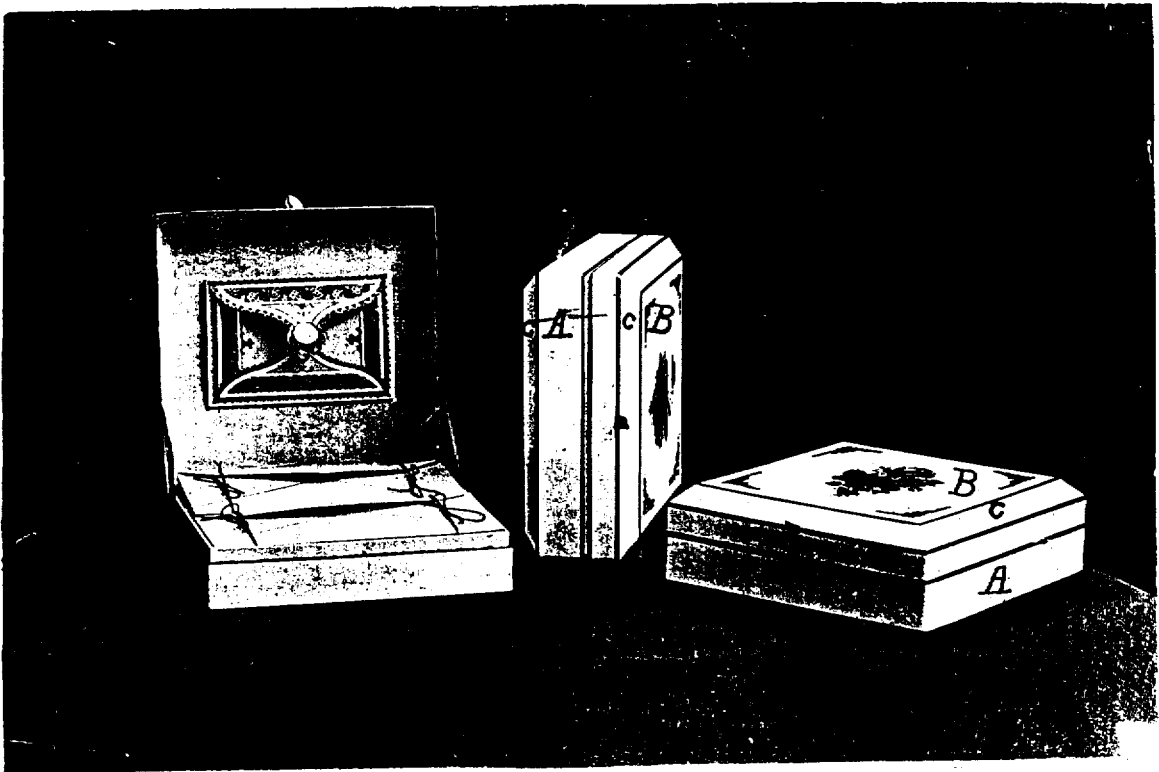

ELISHA MORGAN, OF SPRINGFIELD, MASSACHUSETTS.

DESIGN FOR PAPER BOX.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,689**, dated January 2, 1877; application filed July 28, 1876
[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ELISHA MORGAN, of Springfield, in the county of Hampden and State of Massachusetts, have originated and designed a Box for Stationery, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying photographic illustration or drawing, making part of this specification.

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying photographic illustration, to which reference is made.

A represents the body or main part of the box, and B the cover, and both the cover and the body of the box are beveled at *c*, the former at the upper edge, and the latter at the lower edge.

By reference to the photographic illustration it will be seen that three views of the box are represented—one with the cover uppermost, one the box standing on its end, and still another with the cover raised and the box filled with stationery.

What I claim as my design is—

A box for stationery, having its top and bottom edges beveled, as herein shown and described.
