

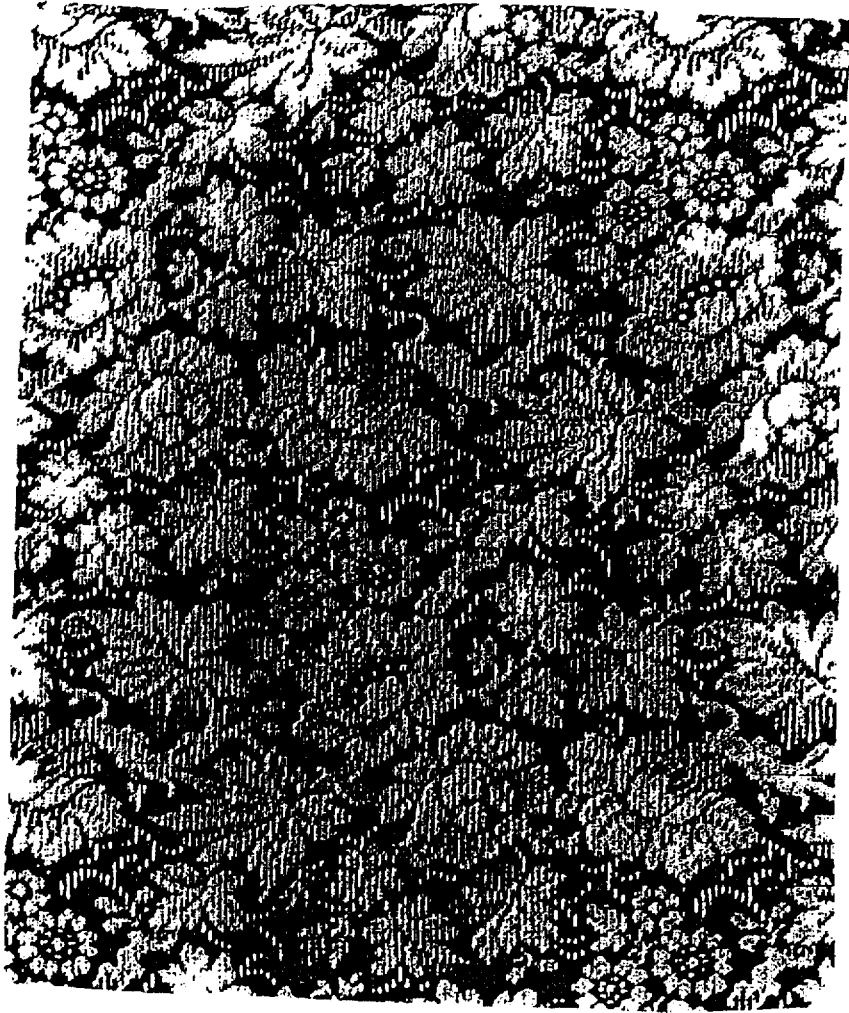

DESIGN FOR CARPETS.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,705**, dated January 16, 1877; application filed January 5, 1877.
[Term of Patent $3\frac{1}{4}$ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ALFRED HEALD, of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented or produced a Design for a Carpet-Pattern, of which the following is a specification:

My design is of a foliated character throughout, consisting of a plain groundwork, on which are arranged stems, leaves, and blossoms, the character and distribution of which are too fully shown in the accompanying photographic illustration to need detailed description here.

Irrespective of the colors employed, I claim—

The design for a carpet-pattern, substantially as described, and as shown in and by the accompanying drawing.
