DESIGN FOR PAPER BOX.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,731**, dated February 6, 1877; application filed December 23, 1876.
[Term of Patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, NATHAN D. BILL, of Springfield, in the county of Hampden and State of Massachusetts, have originated a new Design for a Paper Box, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying photographs, making a part of this specification.

The sides of this box are pyramidal, and the cover flat on the top. The base of the box is ornamented by a narrow embossed border, and the top of the cover by embossed colored

flower pictures in the center and on each corner.

What I claim is—

A design for a pyramidal-shaped box, ornamented with a narrow embossed border around the base, and the cover flat, and ornamented with embossed flower pictures in the center and on each corner.
