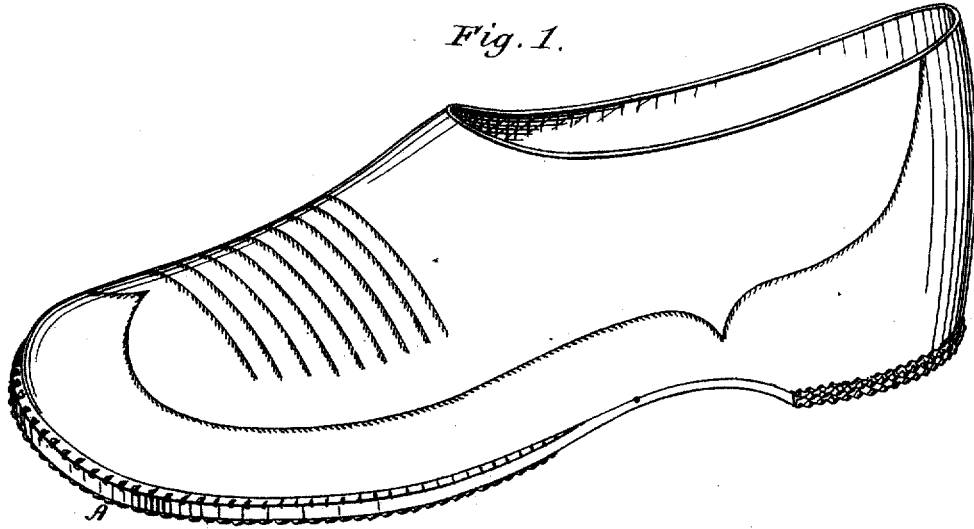
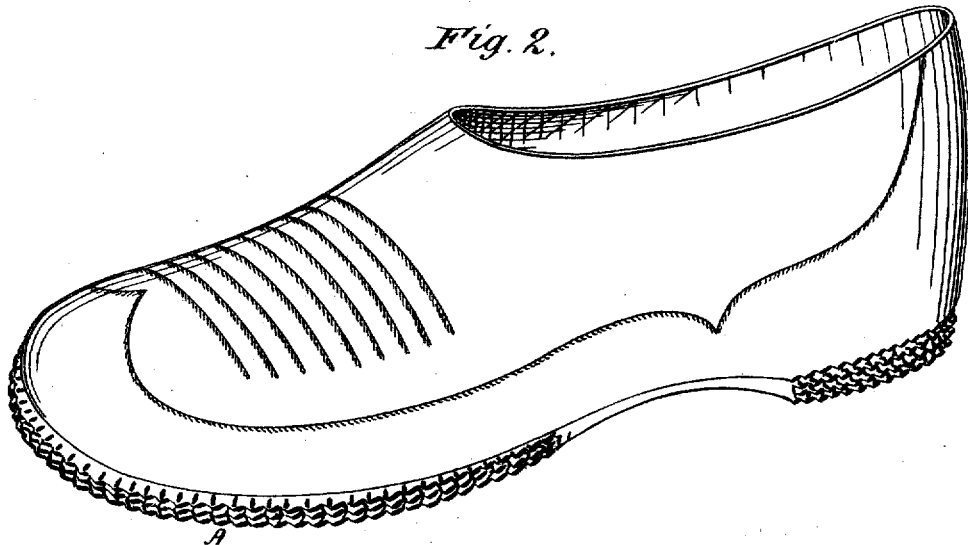

DESIGN FOR RUBBER SHOES.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,759**, dated February 20, 1877; application filed January 24, 1877.
[Term of Patent 14 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JOSEPH PIENOVI, of Newark, New Jersey, have invented a new and original Design for Vulcanized India-Rubber Overshoes, of which the following is a specification:

The characteristic of this design is, that the edge of the sole of a rubber overshoe is molded or formed so as to slightly project beyond the vamp or upper, and this projecting portion is marked to imitate the sewing or stitching marks usually formed on leather soles. In other words, I make a rubber overshoe the edges of whose sole project, and are marked

so as to resemble in general appearance the stitched sole of a leather shoe.

This design is shown at A in Figures 1 and 2 of the accompanying drawing.

What I claim, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The design for rubber overshoes, having a corrugated or otherwise formed sole imitating stitching, as herein shown and described.
