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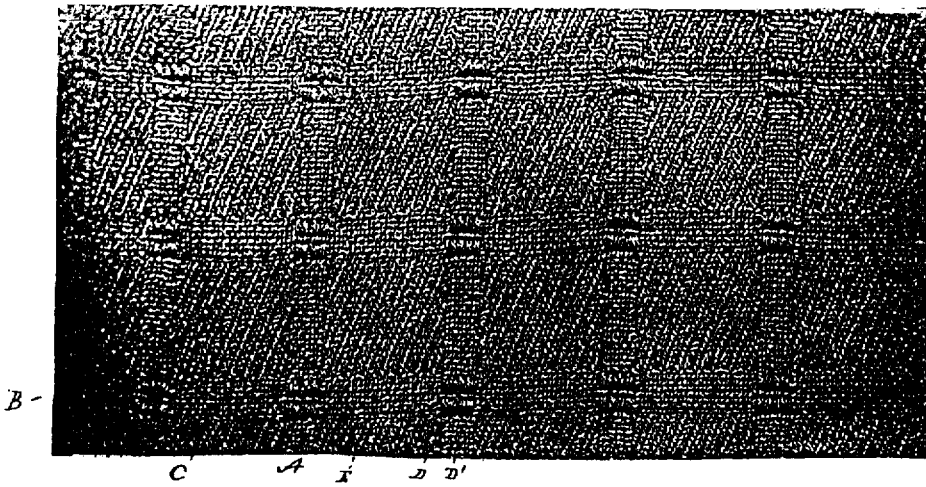

## DESIGN FOR CASSIMERE.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,765**, dated February 27, 1877; application filed February 13, 1877.  
[Term of Patent  $3\frac{1}{4}$  years.]

*To all whom it may concern :*

Be it known that I, HORACE A. KIMBALL, of Pascoag, town of Burrillville, county of Providence, and State of Rhode Island, have originated and designed a Pattern for Cassimere or other Fabrics, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying photographic illustration, making part of this specification.

The body or ground of the fabric is striped with parallel longitudinal stripes A and parallel stripes B, which cross the stripes A at right angles, thus forming checks or squares C. Two elongated spots, D and D', occur at the intersection of the stripes A and B. Di-

agonal twills or twilled stripes E connect the said stripes A and B.

The colors of the body or ground and stripes may be varied at pleasure without departing from the spirit of my invention.

Having thus described my invention, what I claim is—

The design for cassimere, as herein shown and described.
