

## DESIGN FOR INKSTAND AND MATCH-BOX.

Specification forming part of Design No. 9,844, dated March 6,1877; application filed February 17, 1877.

[Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, OTTO F. FOGELSTRAND, of New Britain, in the county of Hartford, and State of Connecticut, have invented, originated, and designed a new and original Design for an Inkstand and Match-Box, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying engraving, making part of this specification. The nature of my design is fully represented

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying engraving, to which ref-

erence is made.

A represents the ink-well, B the cover, C the base, and D the cover of the match-receptacle.

The base is rectangular in form, and at one is a depression for the ink-well A, and at the other end is the match-receptacle provided with cover D, having a knob in its center, and its top ornamented in relief. The ink-well cover B is round in top view, the sides in profile forming first an ogee, then a cove, then

a truncated cone surmounted by a rounded tip. The ogee portion is ornamented by a row of leaflets, a concentric raised ledge intersecting raised ornaments and the base of the leaflets all on a roughened ground. The parts above the ogee are ornamented by fine bars running downward and outward.

I claim as my invention—

1. In an inkstand, the design for the base C rectangular in plan view, and having the ink-well depression at one end, and the match-receptacle and cover D at the other end, substantially as described.

2. In an inkstand, the design for the cover B, having the ogee-cove and rounded-tipped profile, ornamented by raised leaflets and bars, substantially as described.
