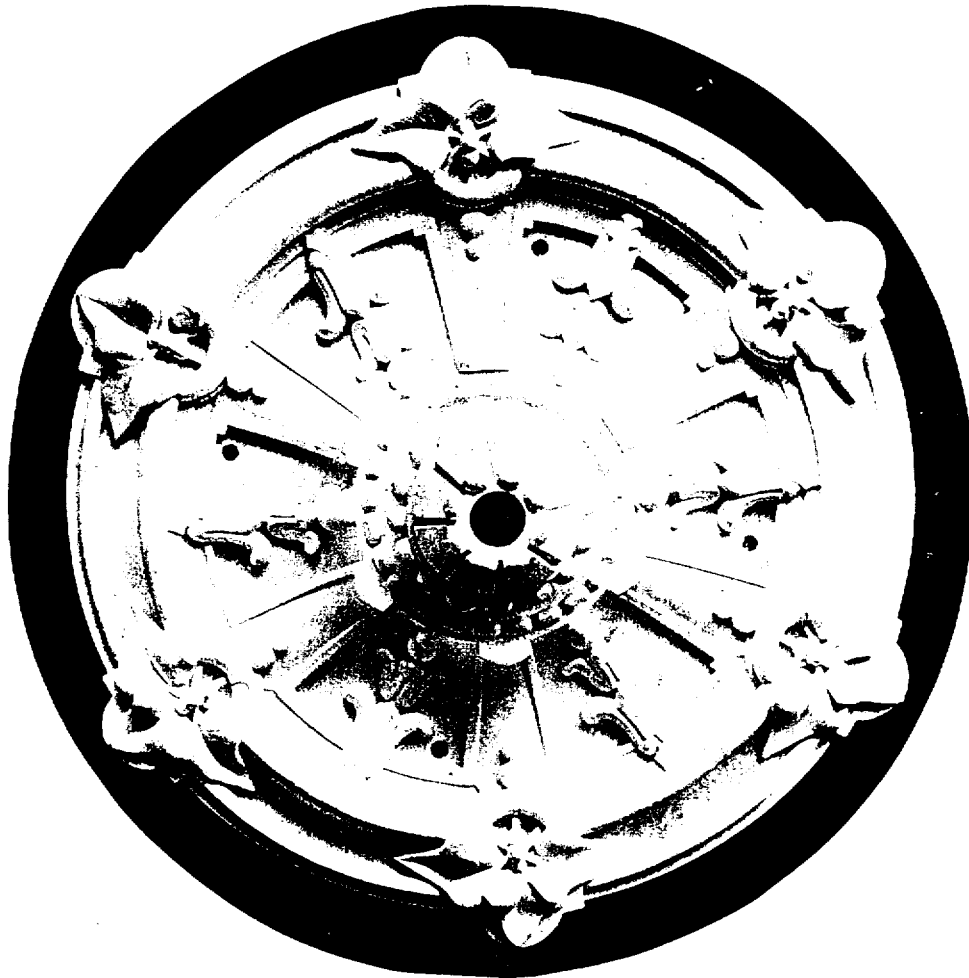

DESIGN FOR CENTER-PIECES.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,846**, dated March 6, 1877; application filed December 14, 1876.
[Term of Patent 14 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, SAML. KELLETT, of the city and county of San Francisco, State of California, have invented a new and original Design for a Center-Piece, of which the following is a specification:

The invention is illustrated in the accompanying photograph.

This design consists in a drop, A, plain-leaved, beaded on base, architectural figures B B in sunk panels, leaf C, with raised sides, molding D, with circular breaks, clusters of

leaves and berries E overlying moldings, outer moldings F, with circular projecting base G under points of leaves.

Having thus described my invention, what I claim as new, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The design for a center-piece, as shown and described.
