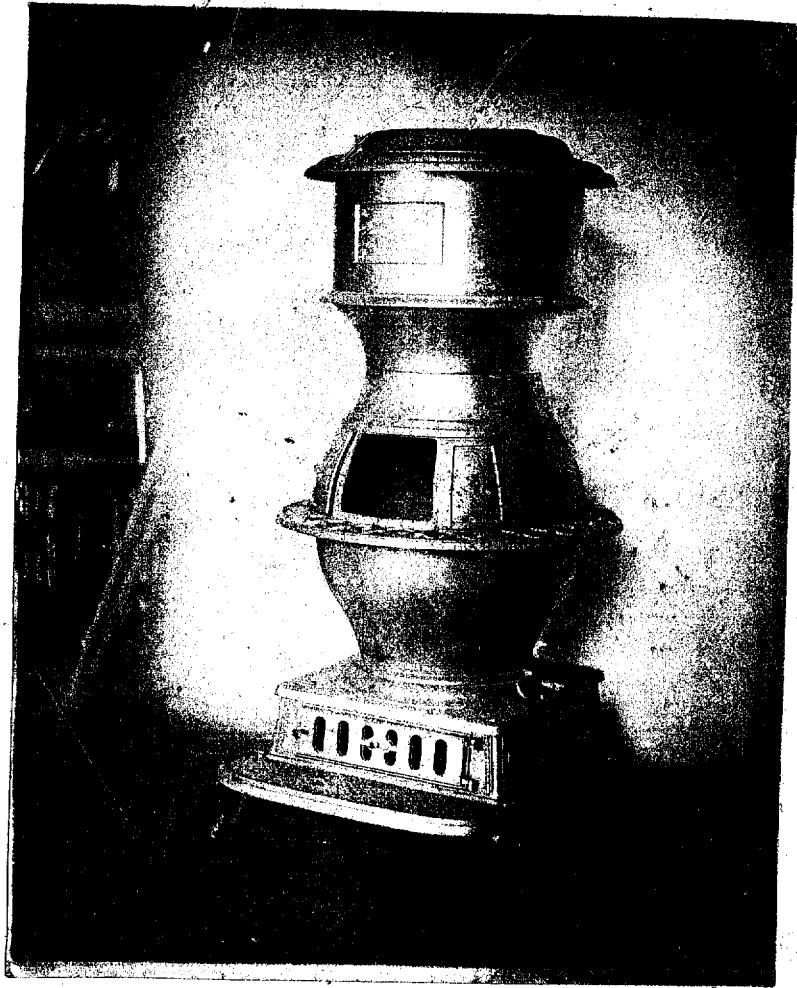

DESIGN FOR STOVES.

Specification forming part of Design No. 9,849, dated March 13, 1877; application filed February 23, 1877.
[Term of Patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, CHAUNCEY H. CASTLE, of Quincy, in the county of Adams and State of Illinois, have invented a new and original Design for Stoves, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings.

In the accompanying drawings, A represents the top or cap plate, the upper central portions of which are elevated, and which are encompassed by a curved edge, convex in outline, connecting said parts with the peripheral parts of the cap, the edge of which depends below its upper portions, which encompass the upper edge of the vertical-sided cylinder B, about the base of which is placed the downward-curved rim D, connecting the cylinder with the upper part E of the body of the stove, which part is curved inward to a reduced base, whereat it joins the upper half F of the stove-barrel, placed obversely, as shown, and connected by the foot-rest H, the interior of which is formed of lattice-work having lozenge centers and sections of the such figures at the lesser spaces. The base of the lower half of the stove-barrel rests upon the platform I, and is encompassed by the orna-

mental rims L, which conceal the line of impact between the barrel and platform or stand, which is provided in front with a sliding draft-damper, M, encompassed by a fluted edge, the corners and sides of the stand being also ornamented by fluting, as shown. The hearth N of the stove is formed in a semi-oval, having a raised edge, and placed directly in front of the draft-damper. The stove is sustained by four legs placed at opposite corners of the lower part of the platform and hearth.

I do not claim, *per se*, any single one of the elements above described; but

What I do claim, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The design for a stove, substantially as shown in the annexed drawings, and described in the above specification.

In testimony that I claim the foregoing design for stoves, as above described, I have hereunto set my hand this 15th day of February, 1877.
