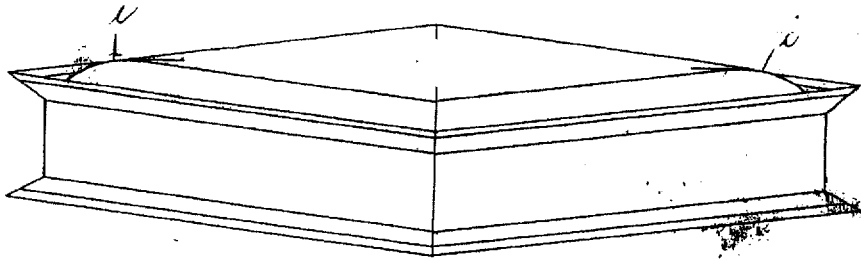
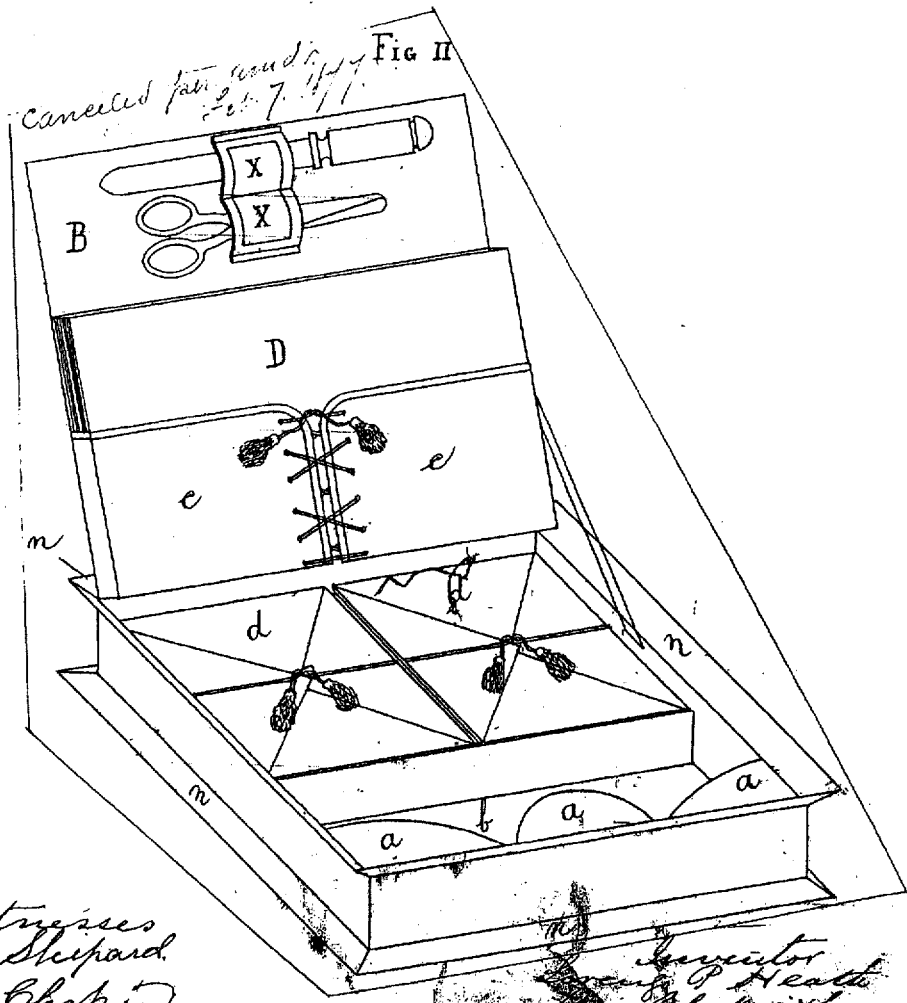

## DESIGN FOR PAPER BOXES.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,867**, dated March 27, 1877; application filed December 26, 1876.  
[Term of Patent  $3\frac{1}{4}$  years.]

*To all whom it may concern :*

Be it known that I, LORENZO P. HEATH, of Springfield, in the county of Hampton and State of Massachusetts, have originated a new Design for a Paper Box, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, making a part of this specification.

This box has a cornice-like projecting border standing out around its top edges, and projecting somewhat upwardly from the line of its junction with the box. Around the base of the box is a similar border to the above-described one, which is beveled downward from its line of junction with the box. The

cover of the box has curved edges and a flat top, all of which is shown in the drawing.

What I claim as new is—

A design for a paper box in which there is a cornice-like upwardly-projecting border around the top edges of the box, and a like border around the base, beveled downward from the line of its junction with the box, and a cover with curved edges, all as herein shown and described.
