DESIGN FOR COOKING-STOVES.

CASE A.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, GARRETTSON SMITH and HENRY BROWN, of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented a new and original Design for a Cooking-Stove, of which the following is a specification:

Our design is fully shown in the accompany.

ing drawing.

On the side of the stove are the oven-door A, fire-door B, and ash-pit door D; and on the front of the stove the damper E, fire door F, and damper G.

The oven-door A has an outer rim, a, and a molding, b, inclosing a panel, b, having a cen-

ral ornamented tablet, e.

The fire-door has an outer rim, a molding,

f, and two mica-covered openings, i.

Beneath the fire-door is a curved projection, m, having an ornament, n.

The ash-pit door D has a central damper, s, and scrolls on either side of the same.

The stove is supported upon feet I, the prominent ornament of each of which is a monogram, t, composed of the letters S and K.

We claim-

1. The design for a cooking-stove, substantially as described, and as shown in and by the accompanying drawing.

2. The design for the stove-foot I, with its

monogram t, as shown and described.
