DESIGN FOR COOKING STOVE OR RANGE.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,872**, dated March 27, 1877; application filed March 7, 1877.
[Term of Patent 7 years.]

CASE B.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, GARRETTSON SMITH and HENRY BROWN, of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented a new and original Design for a Cooking Stove or Range, of which the following is a specification:

Our design is fully shown in the accompanying drawing.

The upper oven-door has an outer molding, *a*, a curved rib, *b*, and an inner molding, *c*, the latter inclosing a panel, *d*, consisting of an oblong tablet with circular corners, said tablet bearing the name "Plato."

The fire-door B has mica lights *f* and a small door, *g*, together with minor ornamentation, which will not need description.

The lower oven-door has outer molding *a'*, curved rib *b'*, and inner molding *c'*, similar to the upper oven-door, but its central panel has an ornament, *i*, of a different character.

The door *h* of the sifting-frame and the door *j* of the ash-pit are similar in general appearance, each comprising an outer rim, a molding, *m*, and central ornament *n*.

The front of the stove has a damper, *p*, fire-door *r*, damper *s*, and ornamented panel *t*, too fully shown to need description.

We claim—

The design for a cooking stove or range, substantially as described, and as shown in and by the accompanying drawing.
