

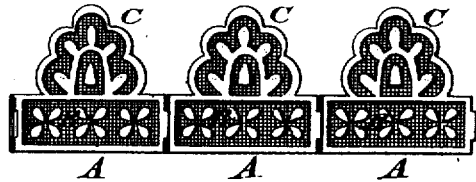

DESIGN FOR A NECKLACE.

Specification forming part of Design No. 9,884, dated April 3, 1877; application filed March 13, 1877.
[Term of Patent $3\frac{1}{4}$ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, GEORGE F. GLEASON, of Newark, in the county of Essex and State of New Jersey, have invented a new and Original Design for a Necklace, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully shown in the accompanying illustration, to which reference is made.

This invention has reference to an improved design for necklace and other articles of jewelry; and it consists of a necklace formed of links having an oblong head or base, and scalloped portion extending therefrom, the ground being stippled and the raised rim and raised interior ornaments polished.

In the drawing, A A represent the links of which my necklace, bracelet, or other article is made. Each link A is formed of two main parts—an oblong base or head, B, and a scalloped leaf portion, C, of less width extending therefrom. The ground of the link is made

dull and stippled, while the raised rims of the head and leaf extensions, and also the raised ornaments at the inside of the same, are brightly polished. The compound shape of the link produces a design of characteristic and effective appearance.

I claim as my invention—

1. The design for a necklace or other article, composed of links having an oblong head or base, and scalloped leaf portion extending therefrom at less width, substantially as shown and described.

2. The design for a necklace or other link, composed of an oblong base or head and scalloped leaf extension, with stippled ground and raised polished rims and interior ornamentation, substantially as shown and described.
