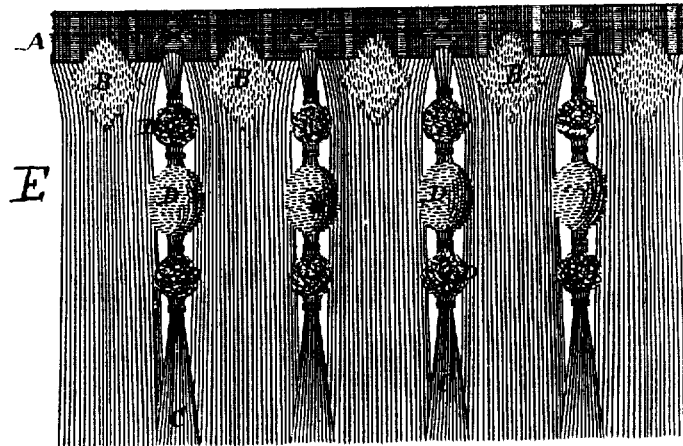

DESIGN FOR DRESS-FRINGE.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,919**, dated April 24, 1877; application filed March 28, 1877.
[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, MAX BLAU, of the city, county, and State of New York, have originated and designed a Pattern for Dress-Fringe, of which the following specification is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part of this specification.

My design consists of a dress-fringe having at suitable intervals, near the top, a series of diamond-shaped ornaments, and at regular intervals, between said diamond-shaped ornaments, a series of ornamented tassels, extending from the binding of the fringe to the lower edge of the same, which, together with the diamond-shaped ornaments, impart to the fringe a beautiful and pleasing appearance.

In the drawings, Figure 1 represents a front view of a piece of fringe, showing my design; and Fig. 2, a vertical section of the same through one of the tassels.

The letter A represents the band or binding of the fringe, which is formed in the usual manner, and to which the body of the fringe is secured in the usual manner. At conven-

ient intervals along the fringe, at or near the band or binding, are secured a series of diamond-shaped ornaments, B, of fur, and between each of said ornaments B are secured the pendent tassels C, to which are secured a series of globular or nearly globular fur ornaments, D.

What I claim, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

1. The design for dress-fringe, consisting of the band A, body portion E, and diamond-shaped ornaments B, attached to the fringe at or near the band of the same, substantially as described.

2. The design for dress-fringe, consisting of the band A, body portion E, and diamond-shaped ornaments B, and ornamented tassels C, substantially as shown and described.
