

## DESIGN FOR A LOCKET.

Specification forming part of Design No. 9,941, dated April 24, 1877; application filed March 28, 1877.

[Term of Patent 34 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, FRANK KELLER and CHARLES FREY, of the city, county, and State of New York, have originated and designed a Pattern for Locket or Watch - Charm, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, making part of this specification, which drawing represents a face view of our design.

Our design consists of a base, a central shield, a beaded rim surrounding the central shield, and beads on the edge or circumference of the base; also of scrolls combined with the beads on the edge or circumference of the base, whereby we obtain a locket or watch charm having a very handsome and distinguishing appearance.

In the drawing, the letter A designates the base of our locket or watch-charm, and B is the central shield. C is a beaded rim surrounding the central shield B, and D are beads on the circumference of the base A. E E are scrolls arranged on the circumference of the

base A, in addition to the beads D, said scrolls being placed on the upper portion of the locket, and on opposite sides of the ordinary pendant F.

Our design is intended to be applied to each of the faces of a locket or watch-charm.

What we claim as new, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

1. The design for a locket or watch-charm, consisting of a base. A a central shield R a

consisting of a base, A, a central shield, B, a beaded rim surrounding said central shield, and beads D on the circumference of said base, substantially as shown and described.

2. The combination, with the base A and its beads D, of scrolls E, substantially as shown and described.
